

Job Description: Cherry Valley Duck Farmer

Hours:	The duck farmer rota identifies the times you will be on duty. This can be found on the animal carers board.
Responsible to:	Mrs Davies and Mr Baker will support you in your role.

Main purpose of the role

1. To support the welfare of our school ducks ensuring they have enough food and water and a clean duck coop.
2. To collect the eggs and track egg production
3. To support the sale of eggs to families including the tracking of productivity and sales

Secondary Purpose of the Role

1. To promote our school farm and develop a real sense of responsibility by taking ownership of the role.
2. To ensure our ducks feel loved and a part of our school family

Main Duties

- Complete daily duck health check and head count
- Complete daily food and water check and top up where necessary
- Collection of litter and sports equipment from the enclosure
- Apply liberal TLC by talking to our ducks and handling them
- Daily duck egg collection
- Daily tracking of egg production
- Comprehensive tracking of the cost of food
- Record sales and keep an accurate ledger
- Complete the Animal Enclosure Inspection Sheet
- Report any concerns to Mrs Davies or another member of Team Gulval

Important Information

- Duck Farmers will require early lunch. *NB: Key Worker lanyard must be worn for identification purposes.*
- Duck Farmers must follow all safety notices at the entrance to the duck enclosure.
- Wellington boots must be worn at all time and must not be brought into school.

Person Specification

- The successful candidate will be kind, caring, able to work independently and over time without adult supervision.
- Candidates must be in Reception, Year 1 or 2.
