

Curriculum Map: Autumn Term 2025

English

In poetry we will be understanding rhyming couplets and patterns writers use and then get to inventing our own during our Poetry unit of work.

Maths

Place Value- Comparing, ordering and rounding numbers up to 100,000
Addition and Subtraction- Number with more than 4 digits using the column method.

Science

Properties and Changes of Materials
We will be investigating lots of different materials and comparing and grouping everyday objects based on their properties. We will even be experimenting with some reversible and irreversible changes!

History

We will be going back in time and investigating the enquiries:
Why did the Saxons settle in Britain?
How did life change during this period for Cornwall and the country?

Computer Systems and Networks
In this unit we will develop our understanding of computer systems and how information is transferred between systems and devices. We will then take part in a collaborative online project with other class members.

Music and French
