

Curriculum Map: Autumn Term 1

English

To start our English lessons, we will be learning a wishing tale 'The Magic Shell'. We are going to be focusing on expanded noun phrases and subordinating conjunctions. We then focus on creating our own exciting wishing tales. Towards the end of the term, we are going to be focusing on instruction writing.

Maths

To start our Maths lessons, we will be looking at place value. This will involve representing and partitioning numbers to 1000. We will then move onto addition and subtraction, building up to 2-digit and 3-digit calculations.

Science

In science, we are learning about animals and living things. This will involve finding out about the different food groups and what contributes to a balanced diet. We will also be finding out more about exercise, muscles and skeletons!

Geography

In Geography, we will be learning about climate zones. This will start by identifying the difference between weather and climate before learning about the different lines of latitude and their importance, as well as being able to describe the different climate zones around the world.

Computing

In Computing, we will be looking at computing systems and networks and developing our understanding of digital devices.

RE

In our RE lessons, we will be focussing on Hinduism and learning the importance of the River Ganges to Sanatanis.

Music and French

In our Music lessons, we will be focusing on one song 'Sparkle in the Sun' where we will learn to read and play on multiple instruments the key notes G, A and B finishing with composing two pieces of your own.

In French, we will be learning some core phonetic vocabulary to support us in pronouncing French vocabulary.

In our DT lessons, we will be designing a castle. We will be building complex structures from simple 2D and 3D geometric shapes.

PE- Sport

In PE sport we will be focusing on orienteering where we will get to know our school grounds and recognise basic symbols and map skills.
