

Curriculum Map: Autumn Term 2

English

In English, we will write informal letters, as well as studying some poetry by different authors and writing our own poems inspired by this.

Maths

In maths we will be learning about the four calculations - addition, subtraction, multiplication and division, as well as looking at fractions, decimals and percentages and how these link to one another.

Science

Science this term involves us continuing to learn all about the human body. We will then focus on learning all about light: how it travels, different light sources, using the terms transparent, translucent and opaque as well as having a go at creating our own shadow puppets to show how this works in practice.

Geography/ History

We are continuing to learn about the United Kingdom: how land is used, the industries in which people work, as well as the type of energy that is used and is available to us.

We will also start to look at the Ancient Greeks as a civilisation and recognise what they did for us and how they shaped our modern day views and culture.

Art and Computing

We are busy in art this term, with us studying artwork by the street artist 'Banksy'. We will research his work, explore drawing techniques and create a final piece inspired by his techniques.

Our computing unit heavily involves us using 'TinkerCAD', an online programme used to create 3D designs - we look forward to seeing what we can create.

Music and French

All the learning in our music unit is focused around how we 'Express, Play and Perform', learning skills needed to be able to perform vocally to a wide range of audiences.

In French, we will continue to develop and deepen our understanding of French phonics and how to talk about our school.

RE, PSHE and RHSE

Our RE this term is based on the Christian faith, where we will answer the question 'How significant was it that Mary was Jesus' mother?'

We will also be learning all about positive money choices and risks in relation to gambling, as well as how our body begins to change through puberty.

PE

This term, we are focusing on swimming, building confidence, working on endurance and perfecting stroke technique.

In REAL PE, we will be looking at developing our static balancing and coordination.
