

Curriculum Map: Spring term 2

English

In English, we will be focusing on different non-fiction genres, such as non-chronological reports, explanation texts and newspaper articles.

Maths

In Maths we will be learning about fractions, ratio, algebra and decimals and percentages. As well as continuing our work on arithmetic skills such as long division and long multiplication.

Science

In Science this term we will continue to investigate how light travels and its properties. We will also investigate evolution and inheritance, recognising how living things have changed over time, how they are adapted to their environment and how this may then lead to evolution.

History

In History we will be continuing our Ancient Greek study, answering the questions 'What did the Greeks do for us?' and 'What evidence is there that the Greeks have influenced our lives today?' We will study chronology, look at the different governance of city states, as well as looking at the Greek Empire of Alexander the Great.

Art and Computing

In art, we will be focusing on the artist Monet and his work, specifically the animals he painted. We will investigate the artist, imitate his style and learn skills that will enable us to create our own final piece.

In computing, we will be creating different formulae to programme our 'micro bits'.

In French, we will continue to learn about 'le weekend', learning new words, phrases and sentences to talk about what we may get up to in our spare time.
