

Curriculum Map: Summer Term 1

English

We will be immersed in high quality stories, rhymes and non-fiction texts. We will be learning new vocabulary and using this within our play. The children will start to retell traditional tales and start to write them. Look out for the story in their bag!

Maths

We will be using tens frames and numicon to help us add 1 to any given number. We will then learn how to subtract numbers. We will be practising how to form numbers correctly and use mathematical symbols to write number sentences.

Understanding the World

We are learning about where we live and exploring the wider world. We will find where we live on a map, listen to stories from different countries like *Handa's Surprise*, and talk about how people live in other places. We will also notice what is similar and different between our lives and other cultures around the world.

Communication and Language

We will develop our vocabulary through Talk for Writing. We will make predictions about what might happen next in stories and re-read traditional tales to talk about the characters and settings.

We will be creating and using a wide range of props to play with to encourage imagination. We will be making puppets of characters. We will be looking at collaging, shading and mixing colours.

We will be practising using scissors to cut along a curved line. We will also be developing our ball skills by refining our aiming, dribbling, pushing, throwing and catching.
