

Curriculum Map: Summer Term 1

English

In English, we will be focusing on different non-fiction genres, such as balanced arguments, explanation texts and newspaper articles.

Maths

In maths we will be learning about how to interpret different types of graph, calculating the mean average and measuring angles. As well as continuing our work on arithmetic skills such as long division and long multiplication.

Science

Science this term involves us completing our unit on light, before we then investigate evolution and inheritance, recognising how living things have changed over time, how they are adapted to their environment and how this may then lead to evolution.

History

In History we will be continuing our Ancient Greek study, answering the questions 'What did the Greeks do for us?' and 'What evidence is there that the Greeks have influenced our lives today?' We will then move onto looking at the impact medicine has had through the ages and how this has changed and developed.

DT and Computing

In DT, we will be incorporating a client's requests when designing and creating our own data logging devices. We will use computer-based software 'TinkerCad' to assist us with this.

In computing, we will be writing codes and using this to help us with programming, using programmes such as 'Scratch' to achieve this.

Music and French

Our music this term is based upon creating and arranging a remix of a song by layering original instrumental parts (drumbeats, basslines, melodies) with manipulated loops using music technology.

In French, we will talk about 'Around Town'. This will build on previous work we have done about subject and verb agreement and using directions and prepositions to have a clear dialogue with one another.

RE, PSHE and RHSE

Our RE this term is based on the Muslim faith, where we will answer the question 'Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead a good life?'

We will also be learning all about positive online relationships, how to keep safe and skills for using the internet safely and how we can face new challenges as we start to think about secondary school.

PE

This term, we are focusing on bat and ball skills, learning about both cricket and rounders skills such as bowling, hitting and fielding.

In REAL PE, we will be focusing on physical skills and balancing whilst looking at the importance of health and fitness.
