English

We will be immersed in high-quality stories, rhymes and non-fiction texts. We will be retelling stories through acting and role play. We will be learning the story 'The Gingerbread Man'. We will begin to blend sounds into words through Read Write Inc. phonics.

Maths

We will be learning what an even number is and what an odd number is. We will also revisit patterns and make our own patterns. This will be supported by many planned opportunities to apply their new knowledge within our continuous provision.

Understanding the World

We will be understanding what Amelia Earhart did and why. We will also be scientists, finding out which materials sink and float.

Communication and Language

We will develop our vocabulary through retelling stories and taking part in discussions. We will engage in circle time and singing daily, as well as learning how to listen carefully and why listening is important.
