

Curriculum Map: Summer Term 2

English

In English, we will be writing a range of different genres such as explanation texts on the causes of WW2 and different forms of poetry.

Maths

In maths, we will be learning all about how to represent data and will be interpreting and drawing our own pie charts. We will also be looking at everything to do with shape and some themed projects too!

Science

Science this term involves us investigating evolution and inheritance, recognising how living things have changed over time, how they are adapted to their environment and how this may then lead to evolution.

Geography and History

This term, we are focusing on Snowdonia National Park. We will be recognising topography, how to understand this and reading and plotting six-figure grid references. In addition to this, we will use field work to further understand what makes Snowdonia so special and attractive to tourists when we visit the locality.

Art and Computing

In art, we will be creating sculptures using mod-rock, influenced by the past creations of the Ancient Greeks.

In computing, we will be continuing looking at the importance of formatting data to support calculations, while also being introduced to formulas and will begin to understand how they can be used to produce calculated data by using spreadsheets.

Music and French

Our music this term will focus on the well-known musical piece 'La Bamba' where children will listen to, appraise and then create their own musical compositions.

In French, we will continue to learn all about 'Around Town', where we look at directions, names of different key French buildings and then create and plan a route for a partner to follow.

RE, PSHE and RHSE

Our RE this term continues with studying the Muslim faith, where we will continue to answer the question 'Does belief in Akhirah (life after death) help Muslims lead a good life?'

We will also be learning about how to face new challenges as we start to think about secondary school, as well as learning all about our bodies and the changes they face.

PE

This term, we are focusing on bat and ball skills, learning about both cricket and rounders skills such as bowling, hitting and fielding, as well as athletics skills in order to get ready for sports day!

In REAL PE, we will be focusing on physical skills and balancing whilst looking at the importance of health and fitness.
